

Paris and was influenced by the art


of Mondrian and Miró. In 1932 he exhibited his first brightly colored constellations, called mobiles, consisting of painted cut-out shapes connected by wires and set

Henry Spencer Moore

Born in 1898, Yorkshire, England. Although he particularly admired the sculptures of ancient cultures, Moore believed in creating a visual language appropriate to the twentieth century. In Paris, during the late 1920s and early 1930s, Moore discovered the organic forms of Surrealist biomorphism and the cool reductivist forms of Constantin Brancusi's sculptures. This ambiguity between abstraction and representation, art and nature, lies at the root of Moore's art. Moore died in 1986.

Paul Jenkins

Born July 12, 1923. His impastoed, illuminated paintings with spiritual, metaphysical qualities set him apart from many of his peers. Jenkins first studied at the American Artists Center where he began his experiments with pouring paint on canvas in various thicknesses to create a sense of dynamism in the process itself. The exposure of white canvas combined with color saturations gives a sense of illumination about his work.






Joan Miró

(1893-1983) Miró is most recognized as a Spanish painter whose surrealist works, with their subject matter drawn from the realm of memory and imaginative fantasy, are some of the most original of the 20th century. These dreamlike visions, such as Harlequin's Carnival or Dutch Interior, often have a whimsical or humorous quality, containing images of playfully distorted animal forms, twisted organic shapes, and odd geometric constructions.

Francisco Zúñiga

Born in San José, Costa Rica in 1912; passed away in 1998. He declined to attend formal art-educational institutions. Zúñiga studied the newly emergent artistic disciplines evolving in Europe and worked for a while in an Impressionist style. His new work is expressed in simplified forms. He has been fascinated with depictions of the female form with an emphasis upon cultures indigenous to Mexico and Central America.

Frank Stella

Born in 1936, in Malden, MA. Stella's art was recognized for its innovations before he was twenty-five. He cast aside illusionistic space for the physicality of the flat surface and deviated from the traditional rectangular-shaped canvas. During the seventies Stella introduced relief into his art, which he came to call "maximalist" painting for its sculptural qualities. Ironically, the paintings that had brought him fame before 1960 had eliminated all such depth.




Salvador Dalí

Spanish painter Dalí was born in 1904 into a middle-class family. He studied at the Academy of Fine Arts in Madrid, where he mastered academic techniques. Dalí also pursued his personal interest in Cubism and Futurism and was expelled from the academy for indiscipline in 1923. He is best known for his surrealist work identified by its striking, bizarre, dreamlike images, combined with his excellent draftsmanship and painterly skills influenced by the Renaissance Masters. Dalí formed friendships with Lorca and Buñuel, read Freud with enthusiasm and held his first one-man show in Barcelona (1925), where he exhibited a number of seascapes. In Paris he met Picasso and Breton. His involvement with the Surrealists from 1929 onwards was colored by his effervescent activity, his flair for getting publicity through scandal and his vivacity, which counterbalanced the political difficulties encountered by the group. Dalí passed away in 1989.










Francis Bacon

Born in 1909, Dublin, Ireland. Bacon is considered to be one of Britain's most exciting painters. He deserves his success, for he has resisted every trend and fashion in art to hack out a path of his own. Though shaped by such old masters as Rembrandt, Daumier and Velasquez, he has been as much influenced by the immediacy of the photograph as by anything else. War, terrorism, gory accidents - these fleeting instants of agony fascinated Bacon. Bacon died in 1992.

Karel Appel

Born on April 25, 1921, in Amsterdam. Appel was influenced first by Pablo Picasso and Henri Matisse, then by Jean Dubuffet. He established the COBRA movement in 1948 with Constant, Corneille, and others. In 1949 Appel completed a fresco for the cafeteria of the city hall in Amsterdam, which created such controversy that it was covered for ten years. Appel died May 3, 2006 in Zurich.

Fernando Botero

Fernando Botero is a Colombian painter born in 1932. In 1948, he started work as an illustrator. In 1950, he went to Europe, where he attended the Academy of San Fernando in Madrid, copied Velázquez and Goya in the Prado and admired the frescoes in Florence. He went on a long visit to Mexico in 1956-57 and the experience of Muralism significantly influenced his future direction. In his own work, he introduced inflated forms, puffing up to an exaggerated size human figures, natural features, and objects of all kinds, celebrating the life within them while mocking their role in the world. He combined the regional with the universal, constantly referring to his native Colombia and also creating elaborate parodies of works of art from the past.

Miguel Berrocal

(1933-2006) Well established and widely acclaimed Spanish sculptor, whose work, often cast in bronze and of a distinctly organic feel, explores the puzzle of existence within time and space through the context of assembling and reassembling. Berrocal's early interest in mathematics and science became an important foundation in the evolution of his sculptures, in which every aspect is exactly conceived.




Sam Francis

Born in San Mateo, California, 1923. Francis early interest was in transforming different sensations of light onto canvas. He was one of the pioneering artists to experiment with "empty-center" paintings and created works that had pigment stains on the periph-ery and much open space where traditionally canvases were filled with paint. Despite the apparent spontaneity of his compositions, Francis was highly methodical and rigorous. Francis died in 1994.

Born on June 11, 1955 in Orleans, France, Brisson's career kicked off in 1972 when he met the encouraging painter Bernard Saby. Inspired by the cave paintings in Lascoste, France, his painting technique is likened to an architectural dig, building up and then scraping away at the canvas to discover what's beneath.



Charles Bragg

Born in 1931, Missouri. Charles Bragg is a foremost social satire artist and is highly acclaimed for his cryptic and humorous portraits. Bragg is a spiritual descendent of Bosch, Brueghel and Daumier, all of whom lampooned the foolish elements of society. His is a unique perspective on the human comedy. Bragg is the constant observer, but never the innocent bystander.



Bernard Buffet


Born in France in 1928, died in 1999. Bernard Buffet was an acclaimed artist by the age of twenty on account of his distinctive style and apparent talent. He worked as a painter, etcher, lithographer, designer, and sculptor and produced religious pieces, landscapes, portraits and still-lives. Buffet's work has a consistent somber mood that seems to represent the atmosphere of the post-war period. His success skyrocketed in the 1950's. Buffet committed suicide in 1999.





Pablo Picasso

Pablo Ruiz y Picasso (1881 – 1973) was a Spanish painter and sculptor. One of the most recognized figures in 20th century art, he is best known as the co-founder, along with Georges Braque, of cubism. A man once criticized Picasso for creating unrealistic art. Picasso asked him: "Can you show me some realistic art?" The man showed him a photograph of his wife. Picasso observed: "So your wife is two inches tall, two-dimensional, with no arms and no legs, and no color but only shades of grey?"

David Alfaro Siqueiros

Siqueiros, together with Diego Rivera and Jose Clemente Orozco are considered to be the three masters of the Mexican school of mural painting. Sigueiros, born in 1896 in Chihuahua, México, was very active in the organizing of México's labor forces, and his political activism resulted in many deportations and years in jail. It was in jail where he created most of his easel works. He incorporated many new materials and techniques, and was the first artist to use acrylics as a painting media. Jackson Pollack was one of his many apprentices. Siqueiros passed away in 1974.



Fernand Leger

Joseph Fernand Henri Léger was born in 1881, in Argentan, France. Léger's earliest known works, which date from 1905, were primarily influenced by Impressionism. His early cubist paintings (nicknamed "tubist") differed form mainstream in their volumetric solidity, in their deep space and in a Futurist "tendency towards the dynamic". His major works are of contemporary subjects, simple in their black contours and bold color areas and endowing the ordinary man with a 19th-century monumentality. Leger died in 1955.








Wifredo Lam

Born in 1902, Cuba, died in 1982. In the early 1930s, the effects of Surrealism were evident in Lam's work, as was the influence of Henri Matisse. He moved to Paris in 1938, where Picasso took him under his wing. During that year, he also traveled to Mexico, where he stayed with Frida Kahlo and Diego Rivera. Lam's own multicultural heritage (as the son of a Chinese father and a mother of mixed African, Indian, and European descent) and his involvement with Santería, a religion rooted in African culture, would soon become integral to his work.



Ernest Trova

Born in St. Louis, 1927, Trova attended no art school and rigorously rejected any form of academic training. During the late 1960's and into the 1970's Trova gained a huge international reputation for his representations of the human condition in his series both in silk screens and sculptures of what he termed, "Falling Man". These complex works depict rising and falling man - often half humanoid - in emotionally charged spheres and circles. In many ways his numerous representations of this theme became an icon or symbol for the dilemma of man in the modern age.



Leonardo Nierman

Born in Mexico City in 1932, Nierman is one of the greatest living abstract painters in Latin America. He has a wide following in the United States. Intense and spontaneous Leonardo Nierman's paintings capture the dynamic forces that rule nature and the universe. Nierman received a Bachelor degree in Physics and Mathematics at the University of Mexico and studied the Psychology of Color and the Harmony of Form in Space.




Leonardo Nierman - Firebird Original oil on canvas 48" X 35"










Raphael Soyer - The Nude Bather Original oil on canvas, signed 20" X 10"






Man Ray


Man Ray - Pont Brise Bronze sculpture, signed & numbered 19/500 5" X 7"
